ALL WHO HAVE CAUSE TO PLEA, DRAW NEAR.

GIVE ATTENTION, YOU SHALL BE HEARD

GOD SAVE THESE UNITED STATES, THE GREAT STATE OF FLORIDA AND THIS HONORABLE COURT. [BACKGROUND SOUNDS]

>> LADIES AND GENTLEMEN, THE SUPREME COURT OF FLORIDA. PLEASE BE SEATED.

>> GOOD AFTERNOON.

ON BEHALF OF THE FLORIDA SUPREME COURT, IT IS MY HONOR TO WELCOME YOU FOR THIS INDUCTION CEREMONY FOR NEW MEMBERS OF THE FLORIDA BAR.

THIS CEREMONY IS A TIME OF CELEBRATION FOR EACH OF YOUR INDUCTEES, YOUR FAMILIES, YOUR FRIENDS AND EVERYONE WHO HELPED YOU OVERCOME CHALLENGES ALONG THE WAY TO THIS PROUD OCCASION. I AM PROUD TO BE A LAWYER BECAUSE THROUGHOUT THE HISTORY OF THIS GREAT NATION, IT HAS BEEN THE AMERICAN LAWYER WHO HAS BEEN THERE EVERY STEP ALONG THE WAY OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF OUR DEMOCRACY.

FOR STARTERS, 25 SIGNERS OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE WERE LAWYERS, 23 SIGNERS OF THE CONSTITUTION OF UNITED STATES WERE LAWYERS.

IT WAS A LAWYER WHO WROTE THE LANDMARK DECISION OF MARBURY V. MADISON AS A JUDGE WHICH ESTABLISHED THE PRINCIPLE OF JUDICIAL REVIEW OF ACTS OF CONGRESS AND THE EXECUTIVE. IT WAS A LAWYER, WHO AS PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, SIGNED THE EMANCIPATION PROCLAMATION, AND IT WAS THIS VERY SAME LAWYER WHO DID NOT REST UNTIL THE 13TH AMENDMENT ABOLISHING SLAVERY WAS RATIFIED IN 1865.

IT WAS A GROUP OF GREAT LAWYERS

WHO PRESENTED BROWN V. BOARD OF EDUCATION TO THE UNITED STATES SUPREME COURT AND THEN COURAGEOUSLY LITIGATED CASE AFTER CASE TO MAKE SURE THE COURT'S RULINGS WERE ENFORCED. AND LET'S NOT FORGET JUDGES WHO, OBVIOUSLY, WERE LAWYERS WHO--AT GREAT RISK TO THEIR LIVES--ISSUED THEIR HISTORIC RULINGS ENFORCING THE BROWN DECISION. THE EXAMPLES GO ON AND ON. SO AS YOU CAN SEE, WE-- THE AMERICAN LAWYER-- HAVE PARTICIPATED IN A CRUCIAL WAY IN THE ESTABLISHMENT AND DEVELOPMENT OF THIS GREATEST OF ALL DEMOCRACIES SINCE ITS BEGINNING.

THIS IS WHY I AM SO PROUD TO BE A LAWYER.

AND THIS IS WHY IT IS IMPORTANT THAT YOU FEEL PROUD ABOUT BECOMING A LAWYER.

WHAT YOU DO OR WHAT YOU WILL DO AS A LAWYER IS IMPORTANT.

NOT JUST IMPORTANT TO YOUR
CLIENTS' INTERESTS, BUT ALSO TO
THE PRESERVATION AND ADVANCEMENT
OF OUR CONSTITUTIONAL SYSTEM.
EACH TIME YOU WILL WALK INTO A
COURTROOM WITH A CASE, YOU'RE
NOT JUST REPRESENTING A CLIENT,
YOU ARE REAFFIRMING OUR PRECIOUS
RIGHT TO DUE PROCESS.
WHAT YOU DO AND WHAT YOU WILL DO

WHAT YOU DO AND WHAT YOU WILL DO IS IMPORTANT.

THE TORCH IS NOW BEING PASSED TO YOU, AND REGARDLESS OF YOUR POLITICAL BELIEFS, RELIGIOUS BELIEFS OR ECONOMIC BACKGROUND, YOU WILL CONTINUE TO SAFEGUARD THE CONSTITUTIONAL PRINCIPLES THAT HAVE MADE OUR DEMOCRACY POSSIBLE.

I WELCOME ALL OF YOU TO OUR BELOVED PROFESSION.

AT THIS TIME, IT IS MY HONOR TO CALL UPON MELISSA VANSICKLE, BOARD OF THE FLORIDA BAR, FOR SOME REMARKS.

>> MR. CHIEF JUSTICE AND MEMBERS OF THE COURT, DISTINGUISHED GUESTS AND FAMILY AND FRIENDS OF FLORIDA'S NEWEST LAWYERS, ON BEHALF OF THE OVER 100,000 MEMBERS OF THE FLORIDA BAR AND ON BEHALF OF THE FLORIDA BAR BOARD OF GOVERNORS, IT IS MY GREATEST HONOR TO WELCOME THE NEWEST MEMBERS TO OUR NOBLE PROFESSION.

FIRST, I CONGRATULATE YOU CANDIDATES THAT ARE HERE TODAY FOR ADMISSION TO THE FLORIDA BAR.

I KNOW THAT THIS IS THE CULMINATION OF YEARS OF HARD WORK, AND YOU DESERVE TO CELEBRATE THIS MILESTONE IN YOUR CAREER.

YOU HAVE CHOSEN TO ACCEPT YOUR OATH TO THE PROFESSION IN OUR HIGHEST COURT, THE SUPREME COURT.

ALWAYS LET THIS MOMENT BE A REMINDER FOR YOU OF HOW IMPORTANT IT WILL BE FOR YOU AS A LAWYER TO HELP YOUR FELLOW CITIZENS UNDERSTAND AND SUPPORT OUR SYSTEM OF LAWS.

IN A PROFESSION THAT IS BECOMING MORE COMPETITIVE WITH EACH NEW MEMBER, IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT YOU ALWAYS REMIND YOURSELF OF OUR CREATIVE PROFESSIONALISM.
ALWAYS LET YOUR VOICE AND YOUR ACTIONS PROMOTE WHAT IS JUST AND FAIR.

I CAN'T TELL YOU THAT IT WILL BE EASY OR WITHOUT CHALLENGE. FOR INSTANCE, SOME OF YOU HAVE ALREADY FOUND A JOB AND WILL BE ADJUSTING TO WORK LIFE. SOME OF YOU MAY STILL BE LOOKING FOR YOUR FIRST JOB.

BUT I ENCOURAGE YOU RATHER THAN FOCUSING ON JUST IN THIS CURRENT MOMENT, YOU REMEMBER THAT A FULFILLING LEGAL CAREER IS A JOURNEY.

IT'S A MARATHON AND NOT A SPRINT.

ALSO REMEMBER THAT FULFILLMENT IS BASED ON MORE THAN JUST PERSONAL ACCOMPLISHMENT.
YOU WILL FIND JOY IN SERVICE TO OTHERS AND TO YOUR COMMUNITY.

GIVING BACK TO THOSE IN YOUR COMMUNITY SHOULD BE ONE OF YOUR HIGHEST PRIORITIES THROUGHOUT YOUR CAREER.

I ENCOURAGE YOU TO CONSIDER
ORGANIZATIONS IN YOUR COMMUNITY
THAT WILL PROVIDE YOU WITH
NETWORKING, FELLOWSHIP AND
LEADERSHIP OPPORTUNITIES.
IT WILL BE A CHALLENGE TO FIND
TIME TO DEVOTE TO COMMUNITY AND
BAR ORGANIZATIONS WITH THE
DEMANDS OF YOUR JOB AND YOUR
FAMILY, BUT I'M CERTAIN THAT YOU
WILL REAP THE REWARDS.
AS WITH ALL COMMUNITY

AS WITH ALL COMMONITY
INVOLVEMENT, YOU ONLY GET OUT
WHAT YOU PUT IN.

THE MORE TIME AND EFFORT THAT YOU COMMIT, THE MORE YOU STAND TO GAIN.

IN CLOSING, I ASK YOU TO REMEMBER THREE THINGS.

THE FIRST IS THAT YOU HAVE EARNED THE PRIVILEGE TO BE A LAWYER.

UPHOLD THIS PRIVILEGE WITH GRACE AND WITH PROFESSIONALISM.

OUR PROFESSION DEPENDS ON IT. SECOND, GIVE BACK.

MANY PEOPLE HELPED YOU GET TO WHERE YOU ARE RIGHT NOW IN THIS MOMENT.

PAY THAT FORWARD BY HELPING SOMEBODY THAT'S LESS FORTUNATE THAN YOU.

AND FINALLY, REMEMBER THAT YOU GET OUT OF YOUR PROFESSION WHAT YOU PUT INTO IT.

STRIVE TO BETTER YOURSELF AND YOUR CAREER BY GETTING AND STAYING INVOLVED IN YOUR COMMUNITY.

ON BEHALF OF THE FLORIDA BAR AND THE FLORIDA BAR BOARD OF GOVERNORS, I WELCOME YOU TO THE LEGAL PROFESSION AND SINCERELY WISH YOU SUCCESS IN YOUR LEGAL CAREER.

THANK YOU.

>> OKAY.

AT THIS TIME IT IS MY HONOR TO CALL ON RICHARD COLLINS,

PRESIDENT OF THE TALLAHASSEE BAR ASSOCIATION, FOR SOME REMARKS. >> MR. CHIEF JUSTICE AND MEMBERS OF THE COURT, HONORED GUESTS AND ESPECIALLY OUR NEW INDUCTEES TO BE HERE AND THEIR FRIENDS AND FAMILY, WE'RE GLAD TO BE WITH YOU TODAY.

I'M HERE TO WELCOME YOU INTO THIS ORGANIZATION OF, LIKE THE JUSTICE MENTIONED, APPROXIMATELY 100,000-- I THINK MELISSA TALKED ABOUT IT, OVER 100,000 MEMBERS OF THE FLORIDA BAR. AND YOU SHOULDN'T BE FRIGHTENED BY THAT, BECAUSE THERE'S ALWAYS ROOM FOR ONE MORE GOOD MEMBER. [LAUGHTER]

WE HOPE YOU WILL GROW AND PROSPER IN YOUR DEVELOPMENT AND CONTINUE TO CONTRIBUTE AND BE A GOOD MEMBER OF THIS ORGANIZATION.

I'M HERE ON BEHALF OF THE TALLAHASSEE BAR ASSOCIATION, AND I HOPE THAT WE CAN GIVE YOU SOME THOUGHTS AND SUGGESTIONS OF WHAT MIGHT HELP YOU DOWN THIS PATH. WE HAVE A MEMBERSHIP OF APPROXIMATELY 750 MEMBERS OF OUR ORGANIZATION.

LAST NIGHT WE MET HERE ON THE FSU CAMPUS AND HAD A FISH FRY WHICH WAS PRETTY DARN GOOD. I DON'T KNOW IF ANY OF Y'ALL MADE IT THERE OR NOT, BUT WE ALSO HAD APPROXIMATELY 87 NEW FSU LAW STUDENTS WHO JOINED THE TALLAHASSEE BAR ASSOCIATION. SO IT'S AMAZING HOW THIS COLLABORATION SEEMS TO BE GROWING, AND EVERYONE IS PROSPERING FROM IT. THIS MONTH IN 1973, 43 YEARS AGO, I SAT IN THE SAME SEATS YOU ARE IN TODAY AND TOOK MY OATH TO BECOME A MEMBER OF THE FLORIDA

THINGS HAVE CHANGED A LOT IN THAT TIME FRAME.
THE PRACTICE HAS CHANGED.
TO A LARGE EXTENT, WE DIDN'T HAVE THIS TECHNOLOGY.
I CAN REMEMBER WELL WE STILL HAD

BAR

TYPEWRITERS, AND WE HAD-- WE DIDN'T HAVE ALL THIS-- I REMEMBER WE GOT A COPY MACHINE, THAT WAS A BIG THING. FAX MACHINE, THIS WAS A REALLY

FAX MACHINE, THIS WAS A REALLY BIG DEAL.

SO IT'S REALLY CHANGED.

AND BY THE WAY, THE FLORIDA BAR NOW-- AND, MELISSA, CORRECT ME IF I'M WRONG-- THE BAR ASSOCIATION HAS ADDED THREE CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDITS TOWARD YOUR CERTIFICATION FOR TECHNOLOGY.

IT CAN BE WITHOUT COST.

IT HAS CHANGED.

WE DIDN'T HAVE E-FILING BACK THEN.

SOME OF US LAWYERS STILL STRUGGLE WITH THAT, AND THANK GOD WE'VE GOT A GOOD PARALEGAL OR LEGAL ASSISTANT, WE CAN HAVE THEM DO THE E-FILING.

EVERY COURT IS DIFFERENT.

I THINK THE DISTRICT COURTS OF APPEAL ARE SOMEWHAT DIFFERENT, SO IT IS SOMEWHAT CHALLENGING. SO THAT'S BEEN A MAJOR CHANGE. AND ONE OF THE BIG THINGS ABOUT INTERNET AND TECHNOLOGY IS WE USED TO THROW THE BOOKS AT SOMEBODY.

YOU CAN'T THROW THE INTERNET AT SOMEBODY, SO IT'S A LITTLE DIFFERENT NOWADAYS.

[LAUGHTER]

BUT, YOU KNOW, IT'S-- THE, I GUESS, BENEFITS OR LEXUS/NEXUS AND OTHER ASSETS THAT ARE AVAILABLE FOR US FOR DOING OUR RESEARCH AND PULLING THE KEY CASES THAT NEED TO BE THERE.

SO THE LAW HAS CHANGED IN THAT REGARD, AND TECHNOLOGY I THINK IN THE LONG RUN WILL CERTAINLY BE A BENEFIT TO US AND BEING ABLE TO CARRY OUR-- I MEAN, INSTEAD OF A WHOLE BOX OF CASES, I'VE GOT MY LAPTOP AND EVERYTHING ON A FILE THERE. IT'S JUST TOTALLY DIFFERENT. I STILL STRUGGLE WITH IT. ANOTHER THING IS THAT WE'RE

SEEING MORE AND MORE ESPECIALLY AREAS OF PRACTICE, WHEN I CAME OUT, EVERYBODY JUST SORT OF WENT INTO A GENERAL PRACTICE.
YOU TOOK WHATEVER CAME IN, WHATEVER WORK NEEDED TO BE DONE, BUT NOWADAYS WE SEE THERE BEING MORE DEFINED SPECIALTIES; TAXATION AND THIS OR THAT AND EMPLOYMENT LAW AND WHAT NOT. SO THAT IS ANOTHER AREA WHERE WE'RE SEEING THE LAW CHANGE. THERE'S MORE AND MORE FOCUSING INTO MORE SPECIALTY AREAS OF THE PRACTICE.

AND ALONG WITH THAT HAS COME BOARD CERTIFICATION.

LAWYERS, AFTER GAINING THE NECESSARY SKILLS AND YEARS IN PRACTICE, NOW CAN SIT FOR AND BECOME BOARD CERTIFIED IN A PARTICULAR AREA.

THE FLORIDA BAR OFFERS BOARD CERTIFICATION, AND THERE ARE OTHER ORGANIZATIONS THAT ALSO OFFER BOARD CERTIFICATION.
SO THAT'S A DIFFERENT THING.
ADVERTISING IS DIFFERENT TODAY THAN IT WAS BACK IN THE OLD DAYS.

THE FLORIDA BAR, I KNOW, IS CONTINUALLY TRYING TO MANAGE WHAT LAWYERS CAN DO THROUGH THE ADVERTISING, YOU KNOW, I TURN ON THE RADIO AND I MUST HEAR I CAN'T TELL YOU HOW MANY COMMERCIALS FOR BILLY BO AND HIS AND HER LAW FIRMS AND ALL THAT STUFF.

SO WE'RE BOMBARDED WITH A LOT OF ADVERTISING, AND IT'S REALLY BEEN QUITE A CHANGE IN THE PRACTICE.

WE HAVE DIFFERENT TYPES OF REFERRAL SERVICE, WE HAVE THINGS LIKE THAT WHICH THE BAR IS HAVING TO GET VERY, VERY ACTIVE IN CONTROLLING.

AND TO THE BEST THEY CAN. RIGHT NOW WHAT IS YOUR NEXT STEP?

AS MELISSA MENTIONED, SOME OF YOU MAY WELL HAVE ALREADY GOT A JOB, AND SOME OF YOU HAVE, ARE STILL IN THE WORKS OF TRYING TO FIND A PRACTICE.

WELL, YOU'VE GOT SEVERAL AREAS.
OBVIOUSLY, YOU'VE GOT THE
PRIVATE SECTOR WHICH WOULD BE
PRIMARILY LAW FIRMS THAT ARE OUT
IN THE COMMUNITY AND PRACTICE.
YOU'VE GOT EMPLOYMENT WITH
CORPORATE ENTITIES, IBM,
DIFFERENT CORPORATE ENTITIES,
AND OBVIOUSLY WE HAVE GOVERNMENT
LAWYERS.

IN TALLAHASSEE WE HAVE A SUBSTANTIAL NUMBER OF GOVERNMENT LAWYERS WHO WORK FOR THE STATE OF FLORIDA, THE COUNTY, CITY, WHAT NOT, DIFFERENT GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES.

SO THERE'S, YOU KNOW, THERE'S VARIOUS PHASES OF GOVERNMENT WHERE THE PRACTICE COMBINES. BUT THE KEY THING IS TO FIND AN AREA THAT FITS YOU THE BEST. AND I'LL GIVE YOU AN EXAMPLE. WHEN I WENT TO UNDERGRADUATE SCHOOL, I HAD THE DECISION THAT I WAS GOING TO BE A DOCTOR, SO I STARTED OUT IN PRE-MED. I REALLY ENJOYED GOING THROUGH THE COURSES, AND THEN I GOT A CALL FROM THE HEAD FOOTBALL COACH AT THE COLLEGE, AND HE SAID, YOU KNOW, THOSE LABORATORIES YOU'RE GOING TO IN THE AFTERNOON ARE INTERFERING WITH YOUR REAL REASON FOR BEING HERE.

YOU'RE SUPPOSED TO BE OUT ON THE PRACTICE FIELD RATHER THAN SOME LAB.

SO I HAD TO CHANGE MY MAJOR FROM PRE-MED, AND I DECIDED THAT'S WHEN I WOULD GO INTO THE PRACTICE OF LAW, AND I FOCUSED AND WENT THAT WAY.
BUT GUESS WHAT?

ALL THAT I LEARNED IN THAT AREA DIDN'T GO TO WASTE.

MY PARTNER AND I BECAME GENERAL COUNSEL WITH THE FLORIDA PATIENTS COMPENSATION FUND, AND WE BECAME VERY INVOLVED IN HELPING-- AT THAT POINT ALL THE MEDICAL MALPRACTICE CARRIERS IN

THE STATE OF FLORIDA HAD LEFT, AND THERE WAS NOT A WAY FOR DOCTORS TO BE INSURED OR HOSPITALS.

SO WE GOT INVOLVED IN THAT, AND I STARTED DEFENDING MEDICAL A MALPRACTICE CASES ALL OVER STATE OF FLORIDA.

AND IT WAS AMAZING HOW THAT KNOWLEDGE THAT I HAD GAINED IN UNDERGRADUATE SCHOOL ROSE TO THE SURFACE AND WAS SUCH A FACILITATION FOR ME TO DO THE PRACTICE.

I HAD A LITTLE BIT, AN ADVANTAGE MAYBE OVER SOME OF MY COMRADES, AT LEAST I THOUGHT I DID.
[LAUGHTER]

HAVING KNOWN THAT.

SO REALLY THERE'S A LOT OF TIMES SOME OF THE THINGS YOU HAVE IN YOUR PAST EXPERIENCE WILL ALSO BLEND WITH YOUR LEGAL PRACTICE AND HELP YOU BE ABLE TO MOVE FORWARD AND JOIN THE TWO. ANOTHER IMPORTANT THING ABOUT THE PRACTICE OF LAW IS PUBLIC SERVICE.

AND IN MY ESTIMATION, IT HAS A LOT TO DO TO BE A POSITIVE THING TO OUR PUBLIC IMAGE.

THE BEST WAY TO ENHANCE IS THROUGH DIFFERENT TYPES OF PROFESSIONAL PUBLIC SERVICE. PRO BONO.

CAN ALL OF Y'ALL SAY PRO BONO? [LAUGHTER]

THAT MEANS WE ARE CHALLENGED TO GIVE OF OUR TIME TO THE PUBLIC AND MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC WHO ARE LESS FORTUNATE AND CANNOT AFFORD COUNSEL.

WE ARE, AND IT'S NOW AN ASPIRATIONAL GOAL, IT'S NOT A MANDATORY GOAL, BUT WE ARE ASKED TO PROVIDE 20 HOURS PER YEAR, ASPIRATIONALLY, OF FREE SERVICE THROUGH PRO BONO SERVICES.
OR YOU CAN PAY \$350 TO A LEGAL AID ORGANIZATION.

WELL, THE TALLAHASSEE BAR ASSOCIATE THROUGH THE LEGAL AID FOUNDATION, WE HELP PROVIDE OUR LAWYERS THAT VEHICLE TO GET THEIR PRO BONO TIME IN.
AND I CAN TELL YOU I CAN GET AN
AWFUL LOT OF POSITIVE FEELINGS
HAVING HELPED SOMEONE THROUGH
THESE TRIALS AND TRIBULATIONS
THAT THEY'RE GOING THROUGH IN
LIFE, AND THEY'RE IS SO TO
GRACIOUS AND THANKFUL SO MUCH
MORE THAN SOME OF THESE
CORPORATE JERKS-- I MEAN,
GUYS--

[LAUGHTER]

YOU DIDN'T DO A GOOD ENOUGH JOB FOR ME OR WHATEVER.

SO I THINK THE PRO BONO IS A VERY GOOD WAY.

ANOTHER WAY IS THROUGH LOCAL CIVIC GROUPS OR CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS WHERE YOU CAN BE GIVING OF YOUR TIME AND ACTUALLY SERVING AND HELPING THE GROUPS WHEN THEY DO HAVE SOME LEGAL ISSUES OR THINGS THAT NEED TO BE DEALT WITH.

AND THERE ARE OTHER BAR ORGANIZATIONS.

AS I MENTIONED, THE TALLAHASSEE WOMEN'S LAWYERS, THE BARRISTERS, THE GOVERNMENT LAWYERS, ABODA, THERE'S ANY NUMBER OF ORGANIZATIONS.

BUT I URGE YOU TO, ONCE YOU GET SETTLED IN, KIND OF TRY TO FIND A GROUP THAT YOU CAN BLEND IN WITH.

AND YOU MAY SAY WHY SHOULD I EVEN DO THAT?

THERE'S SEVERAL REASONS I BELIEVE YOU SHOULD.

IN MOST MAJOR CITY IN THE STATE OF FLORIDA, THERE IS A BAR ASSOCIATION, A LOCAL ORGANIZATION.

I THINK FIRST THING IS TO FIND A MENTOR, SOMEONE WHO'S A MEMBER OF THE BAR IN THAT COMMUNITY THAT YOU CAN JOIN WITH AND TO MAYBE HAVE LUNCH WITH TO OCCASIONALLY AND TO SHARE THINGS AND QUESTIONS YOU HAVE, SOMEONE YOU TRUST AND MAYBE SOMEBODY IN YOUR OWN FIRM.

IT MAY NOT BE, BUT I WOULD SAY THAT WOULD BE THE FIRST THING,

TO HELP GIVE YOU SOME ADVICE AND SOME GUIDANCE AND MOVE YOU ALONG.

I THINK ALSO THE ORGANIZATIONS DO HAVE A GOOD SOCIAL ATMOSPHERE AND A PLEASANT PLACE, AND YOU GET TO MEET ALL THE LAWYERS.

MOST ALL THE LAWYERS ARE GOING TO BE IN THESE ORGANIZATIONS AND MARKETING.

AND THAT REMINDS ME OF A STORY. A SENIOR LAWYER TOLD ME THERE'S TWO KIND OF LAWYERS, THERE'S GRINDERS AND THERE'S FINDERS. ANY OF YOU HAVE ANY IDEA WHAT A GRINDER IS?

THAT'S SOMEBODY IN THERE SITTING THERE DOING THOSE BILL ABLE HOURS ALL DAY.

THE FOUNDER IS INITIATING CLIENTS AND BRINGING BUSINESS INTO THE FIRM.

THE GOAL IS, OBVIOUSLY, TO DO A GOOD JOB DOING YOUR BILLABLE HOUR WORK, BUT ALSO TO BRING IN NEW CLIENTS.

BECAUSE A LOT OF THESE SALARY COMPENSATIONS ALSO TAKE INTO ACCOUNT ORIGINATION OF NEW CLIENTS.

WELL, GUESS WHAT? APPROXIMATELY 80% OF REFERRALS COME FROM OTHER LAWYERS. OTHER LAWYERS.

WHERE ARE YOU GOING TO MEET THEM?

AT THE LOCAL BAR ASSOCIATION OR GO INTO THE FLORIDA BAR ANNUAL MEETINGS AND WHAT NOT.

SO I REALLY SUGGEST THAT YOU DO THAT.

ALSO THROUGH THE LOCAL BAR ORGANIZATIONS YOU CAN GET FREE CLE.

THE TALLAHASSEE BAR PUTS ON FREE CLES WITH SOME FREQUENCY.

THEY'RE FREE TO TALLAHASSEE BAR MEMBERS.

NONMEMBERS HAVE TO PAY A MINIMAL FEE FOR IT.

AND ALSO AS I MENTIONED BEFORE, THE TALLAHASSEE BAR AND OTHER BAR ORGANIZATIONS HELP WITH FULFILLING THE PRO BONO SERVICE WHICH MAKES IT MUCH, MUCH EASIER.

AND THERE'S OTHER ORGANIZATIONS. THERE'S THE NATIONAL

ORGANIZATION OF THE AMERICAN BAR ASSOCIATION, FLORIDA DEFENSE LAWYERS, INTERNATIONAL

ASSOCIATION OF THE DEFENSE COUNSEL, DRI.

THOSE ARE ALL VERY GOOD FOR, AGAIN, THE SAME THING.

THE BOARD CERTIFICATION PROCESS, I WOULD URGE YOU AT SOME POINT IN TIME MANY YOUR PRACTICE TO BE THINKING ABOUT DOING THAT.

I CURRENTLY SERVE ON THE MORE THAN BOARD OF PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY ATTORNEYS WHICH THAT DEALS WITH MEDICAL MALPRACTICE, AMERICAN BOARD OF PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY ATTORNEYS, AND I HAPPEN TO ALSO BE PRESIDENT OF THAT ORGANIZATION.

I GET EXTRA MONEY FOR DOING THAT TOO.

BUT TO DO THESE THINGS, I THINK IT REALLY HELPS US TO FIGHT TO IMPROVE THE PUBLIC IMAGE OF LAWYERS.

AND WE'RE NOT CROOKS, CHEATS AND LIAR, YOU KNOW, THEY WOULD HAVE YOU BELIEVE.

AND THE BIGGEST THING IS WE'VE GOT THIS 90/10 RULE.

10% OF THE LAWYERS CREATE 90% OF THE PROBLEMS.

AND THANK GOODNESS THE COURT AND THE BAR DO THE BEST THEY CAN TO SANCTION AND TO DO, TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION TO HAVE THEM PAY FOR THEIR CRAZINESS.

I THINK A LOT OF THE ISSUES NOWADAYS HAS TO DO WITH US WANTING TO BE REAL VIGOROUS IN FIGHTING TO DEFEND AND TO WORK. WHAT I'VE FOUND IS YOU DO TO THE E-MAILS, OFTENTIMES I AM COMMUNICATING WHILE I'M STILL IN A RAGE.

YOU SORRY RAT, I CAN'T BELIEVE YOU'RE DOING THAT.

WELL, YOU THINK BACK IN TIME OR I THINK BACK IN TIME IN THE OLD DAYS I WOULD DICTATE A DOCUMENT LIKE THAT, IT WOULD GO TO MY SECRETARY, AND SHE WOULD HOLD IT FOR 20 OR 30 MINUTES, AND SHE'D COME TO ME AND SAY, YOU MAY WANT TO RETHINK THIS THING.
BUT WITH E MAILS TOO OFTEN WE

BUT WITH E MAILS TOO OFTEN WE FIRE THAT THING OUT WHILE WE'RE STILL IN A MOMENT OF RAGE OR PASSION, AND I CHALLENGE YOU TO WAIT.

TAKE A STEP BACK AND CALM DOWN AND TO BE COMMUNICATING WITH OPPOSING COUNSEL OR WITH WHOMEVER WITH A CALM, COOL AND AN ATTITUDE THAT WILL BE RESPECTABLE.

REACT OR RESPOND, AND THAT'S WHAT I THINK IT IS.

IT'S SORT OF THAT FIGHT OR FLIGHT RESPONSE.

SO I'M ASKING YOU TO TAKE THE TIME TO BE COURTEOUS AND BE PROFESSIONAL.

BUT I WOULD SAY, IN CLOSING, THAT THE MAJOR THING WE CAN DO IS TO FIGHT TO BRING CIVILITY TO PRACTICE OF LAW.

AND I URGE YOU TO DO THAT. THANK YOU VERY MUCH.

I'M GOING TO RELISH THE NEXT FEW MINUTES.

ON BEHALF OF THE NEARLY 26,000 YOUNG LAWYERS IN THE STATE OF FLORIDA, I WANT TO CONGRATULATE YOU ON YOUR TREMENDOUS ACCOMPLISHMENT.

YOU'VE PASSED THE DREADED BAR EXAM IN FLORIDA AND ARE ABOUT TO BE SWORN INTO ONE OF MOST DIVERSE AND VIBRANT BARS IN THE COUNTRY.

YOU'RE PART OF THE YLD FOR YOUR FIRST FIVE YEARS OF PRACTICE OR THROUGH YOUR 36TH BIRTHDAY,

WHICHEVER IS LATER.

TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE FREE WEBINARS AND VARIOUS CLES THAT THE YLD OFFERS FREE ONLINE FOR ALL OF YOU.

FOR THE DAREDEVILS OUT THERE, THE YLD RECENTLY CREATED A PAGE ON ITS WEB SITE WITH TONS OF INFORMATION ON HOW TO START YOUR OWN FIRM.

THE WEB PAGE, FLAYLD.ORG-- I'M GLAD IT'S ME, NOT ME THIS TIME, I'VE DONE THAT BEFORE-- FLAYLD.ORG HAS LOTS OF INFORMATION, AND I STRONGLY ENCOURAGE COURAGE EACH OF YOU TO CHECK IT OUT AND SEE HOW YOU CAN GET INVOLVED.

JOIN A LOCAL BAR ASSOCIATION. YOU'VE HEARD DICK AND MELISSA TALK ABOUT THIS.

BUT MANY OF THEM HAVE YOUNG LAWYERS' SECTIONS THAT CATER TO LAWYERS LIKE YOU AND ARE RUN BY LAWYERS LIKE YOU.

I HADN'T REALLY APPEARED BEFORE THEM BEFORE.

SEEK THEM OUT AND CULTIVATE THOSE RELATIONSHIPS BOTH INTERNALLY AT WHATEVER OFFICE YOU END UP GOING TO OR EXTERNALLY AS WELL.

MENTORS CAN LAST A LIFETIME.

RELATIONSHIP.

PEOPLE SAY IT TAKES A LIFETIME TO BUILD A GOOD REPUTATION AND ONE LOUSY MISTAKE TO MESS IT UP. YOU MAY HEAR THIS A LOT OVER THE NEXT FEW YEARS, BUT DON'T LET IT FREAK YOU OUT.

AND ALWAYS BE KIND IN ALL OF YOUR INTERACTIONS WITH OTHERS, WHETHER IT BE A JUDGE, A SENIOR LAWYER, A FELLOW LAWYER, A LEGAL ASSISTANT, A PARALEGAL OR THE JANITORIAL STAFF IN YOUR BUILDING.

BE KIND TO EVERYONE.

TREAT OTHERS WITH RESPECT EVEN WHEN YOU KNOW THEY DON'T DESERVE

AND WHEN YOU MAKE A MISTAKE-WHICH YOU WILL DO, I KNOW THAT I
HAVE MADE PLENTY OF DOOZIES IN
MY CAREER SO FAR-- OWN IT, SAY
YOU'RE SORRY AND LEARN FROM IT.
BASICALLY, BE THE KIND OF LAWYER
THAT YOUR GRANDMOTHER WOULD BE
PROUD OF, AND YOU'LL PROBABLY
NEVER GO WRONG.

THIRD, DO GOOD AND GIVE BACK.
IT'S AN ALARMING STATISTIC, BUT
SOME 80% OF LOW TO MODERATE
INCOME FLORIDIANS GO WITHOUT
LEGAL REPRESENTATION THEY NEED
BECAUSE THEY CAN'T AFFORD IT.
OVER 90% OF OUR CITIZENS
REPRESENT THEMSELVES IN DOMESTIC
VIOLENCE, DEBT COLLECTION AND
EVICTION DISPUTES.

THE ONLY WAY THEY WILL GET LEGAL REPRESENTATION IS IF LAWYERS LIKE YOU DONATE THEIR TIME. DOING PRO BONO WORK IS ONE OF

THE THINGS THAT SETS OUR PROFESSION APART FROM ALL THE OTHERS.

YOU SHOULD DO IT NOT JUST BECAUSE YOU HAVE TO REPORT HOW MANY HOURS YOU'VE DONE ON YOUR ANNUAL BAR REGISTRATION FORM, BUT BECAUSE THEY CAN BE SOME OF THE MOST REWARDING CASES YOU'LL EVER WORK ON.

IF THAT'S NOT REASON ENOUGH, THEY'RE A GREAT WAY TO GET ACTUAL COURTROOM EXPERIENCE YOU MAY NOT OTHERWISE GET EARLY ON IN YOUR CAREER.

SO IT'S A TRULY WIN/WIN FOR EVERYONE.

FOURTH AND FINALLY, DON'T EVER FORGET WHO YOU ARE.

OUR PROFESSION IS AN IMPORTANT AND MEANINGFUL ONE, BUT IT ALSO COMES WITH JUST A LITTLE BIT OF STRESS FROM TIME TO TIME.

SOME OF THAT STRESS COMES FROM
THE NATURE OF THE WORK, SOME OF
IT COMES FROM LOOMING DEADLINES.
THE MORE SENIOR LAWYERS FOR WHOM
WE WORK, OPPOSING COUNSEL AND
EVEN SOME OF OUR CLIENTS.

MANY LAWYERS ARE PERFECTIONISTS AND CREATE UNNECESSARY STRESS FOR THEMSELVES.

I KNOW I AM MY OWN WORST ENEMY AT TIMES WHEN IT COMES TO DEALING WITH THE EVERYDAY STRESSES OF THE PROFESSION.
IT'S IMPORTANT THAT YOU MAKE TIME TO BE WITH YOUR FAMILY, TO BE WITH YOUR LOVED ONES.
TAKE TIME AWAY FROM WORK TO DO THE THINGS YOU LOVE AND RELAX YOU.

WORK OUT, SEE A MOVIE, GO TO THE BEACH FOR A DAY.

AND IF ALL ELSE FAILS, BINGE WATCH THE LATEST SEASON OF THE REAL HOUSEWIVES OF NEW YORK CITY.

THERE IS NOT A BETTER WAY TO MAKE YOU FEEL GOOD ABOUT YOUR OWN STRUGGLES THAN WATCHING THAT SHOW.

[LAUGHTER]

IF YOU HAVE A SENSE OF HUMOR,

DON'T LOSE ONE.

IF YOU DON'T HAVE A SENSE OF HUMOR, FIND ONE.

LAUGHTER AND JOKES ARE OFTEN THE BEST REMEDY FOR A STRESSFUL SITUATION.

YOU'RE A HUMAN BEING FIRST AND A LAWYER SECOND.

IF YOU TAKE CARE OF YOURSELF AND MAINTAIN A GOOD WORK/LIFE BALANCE AND TRY NOT TO TAKE YOURSELF OR THE JOB TOO SERIOUSLY, YOU'LL BE A HAPPIER AND HEALTHIER PERSON WHICH WILL MAKE YOU A BETTER LAWYER.

OUR PROFESSION IS A MOBILE AND EXCITING ONE, AND I AM SO THRILLED FOR EACH OF YOU AS YOU BEGIN YOUR JOURNEY.

AGAIN, ON BEHALF OF ENTIRE YOUNG LAWYER DIVISION-- OF WHICH YOU ARE NOW OFFICIALLY A MEMBER-- I WELCOME YOU TO THE PROFESSION.

FOR THAT PURPOSE, IT IS MY HONOR TO CALL UPON JAIME LAPIDUS. IF I BUTCHERED YOUR NAME, I APOLOGIZE.

CHIEF JUSTICE, MEMBERS OF THE COURT, INDUCTEES, PROUD MEMBERS OF THE AUDIENCE, I'D LIKE TO BEGIN BY THANKING THE CHIEF JUSTICE AND THE COURT FOR OFFERING ME THIS GRACIOUS INVITATION TO SPEAK TODAY. WHEN I RECEIVED THE PHONE CALL INVITING ME TO SPEAK, I WAS TRULY SPEECHLESS, AND FOR THOSE WHO KNOW ME, THAT'S AN EXTREMELY RARE THING, FOR ME TO BE SPEECHLESS.

I ALWAYS KIND OF HAVE SOMETHING TO SAY.

IN FACT, AT MANY MOMENTS IN MY

LIFE THAT HAVE SHAPED MY LIFE CAME AS A RESULT OF THAT VERY PROBLEM AND GIFT.

MY INTENTION TODAY IS NOT TO GIVE YOU MY LIFE STORY AS WE ALL HAVE DIFFERENT STORIES, AND EVERY PERSON IN THEIR LIFE HAS THEIR OWN STRUGGLE, SACRIFICE AND SUCCESS.

I'VE FOUND THE EASIEST WAY TO ANSWER THIS QUESTION IS TO EXPLAIN THAT I VIEW THE PRACTICE OF LAW AN ENGINE OF DEFENSE IN TERMS OF PATRIOTISM.

I BELIEVE THAT WE ARE FORTUNATE TO LIVE IN THE GREATEST NATION ON EARTH.

THIS GREATNESS, PRESERVED IN THE VERY DOCUMENTS THAT YOU WILL

SOON TAKE OATHS TO UPHOLD, WAS BORN OUT OF THE PRACTICE OF LAW AND PURSUIT OF JUSTICE, EQUALITY AND PROGRESSION FROM THOSE WHO AND OPPRESSED AND PERSECUTED US. WE LIVE IN A NATION GOVERNED BY LAWS DESIGNED BY THOSE WHO FOUGHT TO HAVE THEIR VOICES HEARD, WHO FOUGHT TO BE FREED FROM INVASION AND FOR THEIR RIGHTS OF PRIVACY AND WHO FOUGHT FOR PRESUMPTION OF INNOCENCE. PEOPLE LIKE JOHN ADAMS WHO IN THE FACE OF THREAT AGAINST HIMSELF AND HIS FAMILY SUCCESSFULLY DEFENDED THE BRITISH MEN ACCUSED OF FIRING INTO AN ANGRY MOB OF BOSTONIANS UNPROVOKED, WHO WOULD FIGHT TO INSURE THAT THESE IDEALS OF JUSTICE WOULD BE THE BACKBONE IN WHICH THIS NATION WOULD GROW AROUND.
