AFTER THREE YEARS AS A LAWYER, MS. SOSA ALREADY CONTRIBUTED AN ASTOUNDING 1500 HOURS IN PRO BONO. THAT'S 25 TIMES THE ASPIRATIONAL GOAL OF 20 HOURS PER YEAR.

SO, TO THE NEW LAWYERS HERE, YOU ARE ABOUT TO EMBARK ON AN EXCITING JOURNEY, I HAVE NEVER LOST MY PASSION FOR THE LAW AND THE ESSENTIAL ROLE OF LAWYERS AS PART OF THE JUDICIAL BRANCH IN OUR DEMOCRACY. THE BOOK OF YOUR LIFE AS A LAWYER BEGINS TODAY. MAKE IT A GREAT BOOK, AND I HOPE 40 YEARS FROM NOW, YOU WILL BE PROUD OF YOUR LIFE AS A LAWYER. YOUR REPUTATION FOR PROFESSIONALISM, AND YOU'RE CREDO OF GIVING BACK TO THOSE LESS FORTUNATE. IT IS NOW MY PRIVILEGE TO INTRODUCE AN EXTRAORDINARY LEADER AND LAWYER WHOSE BOOK OF HIS LEGAL CAREER IS A GREAT READ. HIS LEGAL CAREER HAS BEEN DEFINED BY IMPRESSIVE LEGAL AND LEADERSHIP ABILITIES AND HIS COMMITMENT TO GIVE BACK TO HIS PROFESSION AND

COMMUNITY. I GIVE YOU MY FRIEND, THE PRESIDENT OF THE FLORIDA BAR, GENE PETTIS. [APPLAUSE] >> MAY IT PLEASE THE COURT? CHIEF JUSTICE POLSTON, MEMBERS OF THE COURT, HONORED GUESTS, FAMILY AND FRIENDS. IT INDEED IS AN HONOR TO WELCOME OUR NEWEST LAWYERS TO THE FLORIDA BAR. ON BEHALF OF OVER 98,000 LAWYERS OF THE FLORIDA BAR, IT IS AN HONOR TO WELCOME YOU TO THE PROFESSION. ONE OF SOCIETY'S MOST NOBLE AND MOST HONORABLE PROFESSIONS. YOU HAVE CHOSEN TO ACCEPT YOUR OATH TO THE PROFESSION IN OUR STATE'S HIGHEST COURT, THE FLORIDA SUPREME COURT. IT'S WHAT GOT YOU TO THIS POINT IN YOUR LIFE. I CAN'T STAND HERE AND SUGGEST TO YOU THAT IT WILL BE EASY OR WITHOUT CHALLENGE, BUT IF YOU ARE -- HAVE A

STEADFAST FOCUS, A HEART AND UNWAVERING DETERMINATION, YOU WILL ENJOY SUCCESS IN YOUR PROFESSION. AND WE MUST AT ALL TIMES BE OFFICERS OF THE COURT, PROTECTORS OF FREEDOM, JUSTICE AND THE PUBLIC GOOD. MY CONGRATULATIONS TO YOU, AND MY BEST WISHES FOR A MOST SUCCESSFUL LEGAL CAREER. THANK YOU.
